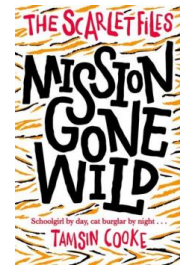
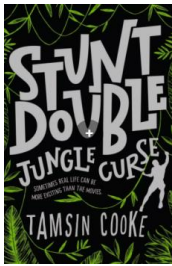

So far, Finn's survived all sorts of smashes and crashes, even an elephant stampede, but it's the secrets on set that might finally break him.

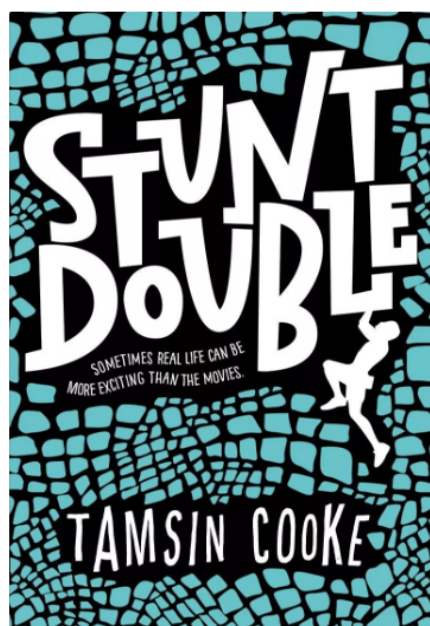
The book will be available to be purchased on the day & signed by Tamsin, the price is £6.99.
