On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday next week, Mrs Hewitson will upload a set of 24 Game cards to the Class Dojo pages for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 between 8am and 8:30am.

If you are able to, please print out the page, then work out how to solve each card and write the calculations in the box next to it. If you are unable to print, please just write out the four numbers, then write your calculations underneath. When you have solved as many of the cards as you can, please take a photo of the piece of paper and send it to the Class Dojo Portfolio page.

If you want to take part on any or all of the three days, you need to submit your answers for that day by 3:30pm. Any KS2 children in school on these days will be given a paper copy to work on during the day and can hand it in before they go home. Mrs Hewitson will approve work on the Dojo at some point after 3:30pm so you will know that she has seen it. She will be kept very busy checking all of your calculations and working out the points for each House – it's a good thing she loves maths!

On Friday 3rd July, the winning House will be announced in the school newsletter, and top scorers in each year group will be listed.
