Good afternoon,

Attached is a letter from NHS Test and Trace which we have been asked to circulate to all families within our school community. The main emphasis of the letter is on keeping children, staff and our wider community safe at this time and the expectations should someone present with symptoms or a positive test result.

I would like to stress again the importance of following government guidelines and ask again that just one adult from each household drop and collect children from school to limit the number of people outside at school at any one time.

Please remember extra kit or clothes are also not needed for clubs and gum shields and shin pads can be stored in pe bags at the start of the week. Football boots are not needed at this time and there should be no toys or items from home brought into school. We are trying to limit cross contamination from items brought in and request again that children do not bring in a bag if they are not necessary. Packed lunch boxes can be carried to school along with water bottles and reading books.

I thank you in advance in supporting our efforts to follow government guidelines.
