

## Y1 Spring 2021

Welcome to our Spring Term in Year 1! For now, it will be a bit different to a normal Spring Term, but hopefully we will all see each other again before too long. For the children working at home, each Monday, a timetable for the week will go onto the General channel. Every morning at least one lesson will go into the subject channel, with the rest of the lessons being added during the day.

Whether learning at home or at school, each day should usually go as follows:

### Reading

This could be reading your own book or reading/enjoying a book together. Please read Book Bag books, your own books, picture books, comics/magazines...anything! Remember that you can access books on Oxford Owl using tatworth2 as the login and password.

### Phonics/Literacy & Language

You will need to use the books and booklets that you collected from school during the first week of term. Please find the videos and tasks for your colour group in the Phonics Team each day.

### Spellings

Words will be set for every child on Spellingframe each week (running from Wednesday to Wednesday). Please write the weekly list into your book and practise writing them. Each day, write the list out again and play some of the games for your word list on Spellingframe. Please complete the test.

### English

This term we are continuing to develop our phonological awareness through rhymes and stories and our fine motor skills to help with our handwriting. When writing, we are focussing on sentence structure and punctuation of full stops and capital letters. We will focus on checking that our sentences have a subject (I, they, Dogger, The United Kingdom) and a verb (went, are, lives, has) and that we have used a capital letter at the start of a proper noun (person or place).

### Maths

Each lesson begins with a mental maths starter, which may be a song, game or a recap of a method learnt during the Autumn term and some questions to answer.

We have started the term learning about addition and subtraction to 20. We'll then move on to place value within 50, measuring length and height, then measuring weight and volume.
