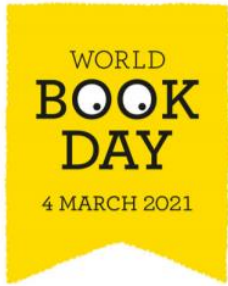


Dear Parents and Carers



Next Thursday, 4th March, is World Book Day.

To celebrate we have many activities and competitions organised to keep you busy during the coming week. Please see below for some competitions we are running this year and how to access the £1 tokens.

Read Aloud Competition

This competition is open to all children from school, and all you have to do is choose a favourite page from a book, poem or even something you have written yourself and read it aloud. Readings will be judged on enthusiasm, clarity and expression. We are asking for either videos or recordings to be a maximum of 1 minute in length. Please send it into school via your class assignment (set by class teachers next week) by Friday 5th March. The winner will receive a £10 book token and runners up will win a book mark. It would be super if you could support your child to choose a passage and help them to practise. The more times they have read it, the more confident they will be when it comes to reading it aloud. Thank you.

Create your Favourite Book Character Competition.

For this task we would like you to create your favourite book character using art. This can be created from any range of media e.g. natural resources, clay, fruit or veg, objects around your home, textiles etc. Take a photo of your finished character, adding your favourite book quote and send in to the home-learning email with the title 'WBD Character Competition' by Friday 5th March.
