Dear parents and carers of year 6,

Thank you for your patience. It has been tricky this year to organise any end of year events for year 6, with restrictions in place and when guidance from the government has often changed. Therefore, your child will be able to leave with you after the leavers' service at around 12 noon. This will allow you to arrange other events off site should you wish to do so. School will of course also be open to all children as usual to 3.30 pm.
