Where children disagreed, the following reasons were given:

The behaviour of other pupils in my lessons is good:

There is some messing around – talking when the teacher is talking; pulling funny faces; children pass or throw pencils; when the teacher tells them to stop, it quickly stops.

The behaviour of other pupils around school is good:

There is some messing around – walking backwards on the run; playing tag on the run; taking too long and chatting in the toilets

My teacher gives me work that challenges me: 4%
